The Landfill will Open Saturday, May 13, 2023

Please break down all mattresses, and place the materials in bags for curbside pickup. Any metal frames can go to the Landfill. If unable to break down a \$20.00 fee will be charged. Please do not bag up your items, attendants need to see what is being disposed of. Do not bring any items that can be picked up curbside, no household trash will be accepted. **We will not be accepting Oil this year.** Landfill stickers are now available at the Town Office or the Town Landfill. Sticker fee is \$5.00. *Looking for a Landfill Attendant, call office for details.*

Curbside pickup is scheduled on Friday. The rubbish service requests that you have your household trash put out by 7 AM to ensure pick up. The rubbish service workers are not responsible for cleaning up any scattered trash.

A 2.5% charge will be added to all transactions with a minimum fee of \$1.00.

Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife requires permit holders to present a valid Maine driver license or state ID, to prove Maine residency. Residents who do not hold a Maine driver license or state ID, are required to complete a lengthy affidavit and have it notarized; the forms are available at the town office. **THIS INCLUDES ALL FISHING & HUNTING LICENSES/SNOWMOBILE/ATV REGISTRATIONS.** Keep in mind that all ATV registrations & Snowmobiles are good until June 30th of each year. **ATV registrations are \$71.00 for renewals and \$72.00 for new registrations.** All non-residents ATV registrations are \$115.00, and 7-day non-residents are \$100.00. Any ATV & Snowmobile renewals can be done online. Boats and new registrations must be done at the Town Office.



Vehicle registration updates:

If you are registering a new vehicle or a complicated registration, please come in **one hour prior to closing**. Any new residents must bring their prior registration upon renewal. If you are planning on transferring a registration, please bring the registration you wish to transfer with you.

~ Message from our Towns Code Enforcement Officer, Mike Falvey ~

The Code Enforcement Officer and Local Plumbing Inspector is in the office Monday afternoons from 9:00-4:00.

Permit Pricing List:

- Building permit minimum \$20.00, .20 cents a square foot for unconditioned space (not heated or cooled) .30 cents a square foot for conditioned space. Please note that you need permits for anything being built, whether a chicken coup, or a house you need a permit with a sketch, and dimesons. If you have any questions, please call the Town Office. We also have these permits on the Towns Website along with a checklist to refer to.
- Electrical permit is \$25.00
- Plumbing permit - new sites require routine site plan for septic systems cost varies \$100.00 plus. Internal plumbing fees are \$10.00 a fixture.

The State of Maine has an Automobile Graveyard (no more than 2 unregistered / uninspected vehicles allowed in your yard). There is a fair number of Recreational Vehicles (campers) in town. Many people use these seasonally and take care of the waste water by dumping at a licensed facility. These campers cannot be occupied for more than 180 days a year and must show proof, with a receipt of the facility that disposed their waste water to the Local Plumber Inspector. I am always willing to work with people when I see progress being made but have also been known to follow through with legal action if the situation warrants.

Now that the Landfill is opening this would be a great time to do your **annual spring cleanup**. Thank you in advance for your efforts in helping to clean up your yards.
